2018 Art on the Vine FAQ

What is included with my ticket?

\$55 ticket includes event admission, access to the Last Bid Silent Auction, a souvenir wine glass, 8 redeemable wine tasting tags + one full pour “coin”, and a complementary light buffet.

Do I need to purchase a ticket to bid on auction items?

No, the *Art on the Vine* Auction will begin online after the evening of the event: Friday June 8, 2018, at midnight. The online bidding portion of the auction will end at noon on June 15, 2018.

Do I still need to purchase a ticket to attend the event if I am not drinking?

Yes, an Art on the Vine admission ticket and a valid ID are required for everyone attending the event. There are no discounts for those who will not be drinking wine, but tasting and pour tickets are transferable.

Are Art on the Vine tickets available on the night of the event?

If the event does not sell out in advance, tickets will be available the day of the event, while quantities last.

May I purchase a bottle of wine at this event?

Yes, bottles will be available for purchase. You may buy wines at any time during the event, while supplies last. A portion of every bottle sold helps raise money for The Art League. There will also be additional full glass pours available for purchase and a portion of that purchase will benefit The Art League.

Will there be food available at the event?

Yes, there will be a complementary light buffet during the event. The buffet will feature picnic fare, snacks, sweet treats, and non-alcoholic beverages. There will also be heartier fare for purchase, such as artisan cheese and charcuterie boards, from our partner vendors.

Are the auction items and wine available for purchase at the event cash only, or do you accept credit cards?

Event admission tickets, winning bid auction items and wine may be purchased with cash or credit.

Is this event raising money for The Art League?

Yes! The auction, ticket sales, and a portion of the wine and food sales, all raise money to benefit The Art League and its programs. To find out more about those programs, please visit theartleague.org.

Where do I park? How much does parking cost?

The closest parking for this event is in the Colonial Parking Lot at 102 N Union Street (\$15), directly across from the Torpedo Factory Art Center at 105 N Union Street. Also nearby is the HB Parking Lot at 115 S Union Street (\$8.50). Both of these lots offer reserved parking spots through Parking Panda www.parkingpanda.com/torpedo-factory-art-center-parking.

Disabled parking is available in the Colonial Parking Lot across the street and there are designated spots on North Union Street in front of the Torpedo Factory.

What should I wear?

This is a festive but casual event.

Can I walk anywhere with my wine?

Legally you must stay within the building with wine during event hours.
