## Student Show: Entry Information February 19–March 1, 2020 art league

Students may submit **one** piece of artwork created in an Art League class within the last year.

**artwork drop-off:** Please deliver your artwork to The Art League Gallery, in Room 21 of the Torpedo Factory Art Center. **Drop-off will be Presidents' Day, Monday, February 17, from 10:30 am-1:30 pm and 5:30-8:30 pm ONLY.** Please bring a completed entry form, which is available on the back of this flyer, online, at the School Office, and the Art League Gallery.

**about submissions:** Eligible work only includes work created in a class at The Art League within the last year. All eligible work submitted to this show will be accepted; judging is only for awards. Smaller works are preferred due to limited wall space. **The following are not eligible for the Student Show: work created in Open Life, Open Studio, or workshops; multiple submissions (such as diptychs) even if you have taken several classes.** Although we take utmost care in handling artwork, The Art League cannot be responsible for work that is lost or damaged. If you are submitting a pastel, please be sure to indicate that on a note attached to the work.

**Sale:** You may list a sale price or mark your work "Not For Sale". In the event of a sale, The Art League takes a 40% commission.

**framing:** 2-D works must be properly framed with screw eyes and hanging wire attached to the back. Clip frames are not allowed. We will turn away 2-D works that are unsuitably framed. If you have questions about framing, please ask your instructor for advice.

**judging:** A visiting judge will award prizes. All award winners will receieve a free year's membership to The Art League & more!

**reception:** The closing reception will be held on Sunday, March 1, from 2:00 to 4:00pm in The Art League Gallery. Awards are presented at 3:30 pm. Please invite friends and family!

**pick-up:** Artwork pick-up will be from 4:00 to 5:00pm after the reception on Sunday, March 1. If you or a friend cannot pick up the work at that time, the work should not be entered. Because we have nowhere to store work, it is at risk for loss or damage if not picked up at the designated time. **Late pick ups are fined \$5 per day.**
